




JOINT DECLARATION


In order to ensure the greater development of friendly relations between the Governments of Jamaica and the Republic of Latvia to promote cooperation in areas of common interest and for the benefit of the two countries, and to act jointly in support of peace in the international community, in accordance with the purposes and principles established in the United Nations Charter and with reference to the relevant provisions of the Vienna Convention that regulate diplomatic relations between states, the Governments of Jamaica and the Republic of Latvia have decided to establish, as from December 18, 1991 diplomatic relations between them at Ambassadorial level.

Signed in New York on the 18th day of December 1991.
