


JOINT DECLARATION
ON THE ESTABLISHMENT OF DIPLOMATIC RELATIONS
BETWEEN
THE REPUBLIC OF LATVIA
AND
THE REPUBLIC OF ICELAND

The Government of the Republic of Latvia and the Government of the Republic of Iceland, being desirous of further promoting relations of friendship and co-operation, have agreed to establish Diplomatic Relations between the two States on the basis of the principles of mutual respect for sovereignty, equality and non-interference in each other's internal affairs.







by the establishment of diplomatic relations.


