


JOINT DECLARATION
on the reestablishment of diplomatic
relations between the Republic of Latvia
and the Kingdom of Norway

The Government of the Republic of Latvia and the Government of the Kingdom of Norway, being desirous of further promoting relations of friendship and co-operation have agreed to reestablish diplomatic relations between the two countries on the basis of the principles of mutual respect for sovereignty, equality, and non-interference in each other's internal affairs and according to the Vienna Convention of 18 April 1961 on Diplomatic Relations.
