I acknowledge receipt of your letter of 29 August 1991 which reads as follows:

"I have the honour to refer to my telefax of 26 August 1991 concerning the intention of the Government of the Republic of Finland to re-establish diplomatic relations between the Republic of Finland and the Republic of Latvia and wish to propose the following:

The Republic of Finland and the Republic of Latvia will re-establish diplomatic relations taking effect as of today.

The diplomatic relations will be based on the general rules of international law as prescribed by the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations of 18 April 1961.


Diplomatic representatives will be exchanged as soon as possible.
