The Embassy of the Republic of Turkey presents its compliments to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Latvian Republic and upon instructions from its Government has the honour to inform the esteemed Ministry that the Republic of Turkey has decided as of September 3, 1991 to reestablish diplomatic relations with the Latvian Republic which were de facto broken due to circumstances beyond the control of the Parties concerned.

The Embassy has also the honour to inform the Ministry that H.E. Volkan Vural, Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of the Republic of Turkey in Moscow has been assigned with the task of conveying this decision as special representative of the Turkish Government and to discuss with the relevant Authorities the practical questions relating to its implementation.

The Embassy of the Republic of Turkey avails itself of this opportunity to renew to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Latvian Republic the assurances of its highest consideration.
